regarding how to record the score points

adopting a different membership payment
structure, such as a multi-tiered structure.
The risk is that of having a significant

for discussion to require new members to
play a set number of rounds at Tilden
and/or away courses before they can
participate in TPGC tournaments. This
would be incorporated in the TPGC Policy
Manual. Charlie Barthold made a case for
having a minimum of six rounds overall
with at least three of the six rounds at the
Tilden Park Golf Course and witnessed.
There were no objections, and this issue
will be voted on at the February 2010
monthly meeting as well.
