(The following remarks were made by Leonard Pytel at the June 11, 2009 monthly meeting of the Tilden Park Golf Club)

**LEONARD PYTEL'S MEMBERSHIP HISTORY IN THE TILDEN PARK GOLF CLUB**

I joined the Tilden Park Golf Club (TPGC) in 1960. This was followed in 1964 with membership in the Bay Regional Golf Tournament group and including being the President for the ten years that followed.

My next action was becoming the Assistant Tournament Chairman of the TPGC in 1971. One of the additional duties during this period was being the Dinner Chairman in 1973, while in the Vice President position. This led to becoming the President of the TPGC in 1974.

Life became easy for a while until I accepted the job as Secretary. At that time, it seemed that the present Secretary suddenly quit the position in 1985. Because I had a typewriter at that time, I volunteered to try the job. As you probably know, I still have the position. However, the typewriter was removed a long time ago and a computer and printer, as well as two telephones, took the place. Also, a lot of storage space is now full, and the working table has no space on which to work, due to the papers that cover it.

During the 25 years in which I have had the position, I was honored in about 1995 by the then TPGC President with an Honorarium for being both the Secretary and Treasurer. In a later year (January 9, 2003), the Board of Directors increased the Honorarium. Also at that January 9, 2003 monthly meeting, the members at the meeting voted to give me a Lifetime Membership Award.

In all this time, I have enjoyed my membership in the TPGC. However, my present feelings have changed and because of that, I am resigning from the Secretary position. Because the club is in the present operation of annual dues collection, and my name and address are on the Dues Statements, I will continue to collect and give the checks to the Treasurer.

I am not resigning from the TPGC.
