GOLF QUESTIONS – Answers to last month's quiz are attached in a separate file sent with the Minutes (or copied below the Minutes in the email version).

NEW QUIZ – June 2010

1. On hole four, your ball caroms off the cart path, and the ball cracks and splits, with most of it tumbling sideways and forward and landing on the green while the rest of the ball lands in the rough. From where do you play your next shot: (a) the green, (b) the spot from where you played the last stroke, (c) the rough, or (d) the spot where the ball cracked.

2. When you arrive at the 3rd tee and have to wait for the group in front of you to clear the right and left side hills, and the fairway, you start hitting 30-50 yard pitch shots from the ground down slope from the tee box onto the teeing ground. Is this allowed?

(3) On the 8th hole, you ask your opponent to tend the flagstick while you putt. As your ball gets close to the hole, your opponent yanks the flagstick out with such force that the hole liner comes out of the hole and deflects the ball from falling into the cup. Do you have to play the next shot from the spot where the ball came to rest?
