NEW QUIZ – May 2011

1. Jeff Ogilvy noticed in the first round of a tournament that his steel driver shaft was starting to bend significantly, and later in the round, it was bent to the point where he could no longer use it. He then DQ'd himself. Why?

2. You hit your ball into a lateral creek, and the water flow carries the ball downstream from in-bounds to OB. Can you drop outside the hazard, or do you go back to the tee for the OB stroke-and-distance penalty?

3. My opponent, without telling me, marked the position of my ball and set it aside on the green. After I putted from the wrong position on the green and holed out, he informed me that he had marked the position and lifted my ball. Should I have been penalized?

Prior QUIZ – April 2011

1. John Rollins drove his ball in soggy conditions and found his ball embedded in a pitch mark. Nearby spectators said it was in another ball's pitch mark. How should Rollins proceed?

Answer: He must hit the ball in the embedded plugged lie. He did, to save par, but lost the match by one stroke

2. Who's away? Your drive on a par three is 10 yards from the hole, and your competitor is on the green 40 feet from the hole. How should you proceed?

Answer: Rule 10-1b states that once everyone has teed off, the golfer farther from the hole plays first, regardless of position. There is no penalty in match play for playing out of turn, but your opponent can make you cancel and replay your stroke. In stroke play, if a player plays out of turn to speed up play, there's no penalty, provided it's not done to give a player in the group an advantage.

3. When playing a round, who tees off first on hole 1?

Answer: Rules 10-1, 10-2 says the order should be determined by a draw, or by lot, which is also the procedure if two balls are the same distance from the hole after teeing off. On the ensuing holes, in stroke play, the player with the lowest gross score on the previous hole tees off first. In match play, the player with the lowest net score has the honor.
